4-H Home Economics Lettermen



Any 4-H Member who is active in home economics projects may "letter" in Home Economics. All that is necessary to "letter" is to complete the requirements in your age level & submit the letterman form to the Extension Office by September 1.

♦ The first year a member letters they receive a "clover" letter as you would see on a lettermen jacket.

♦ Bronze, Silver, and Gold pins in the shape of the letter "H" are awarded in respective age levels. A member can "letter" at anytime, even if they did not begin as a novice, but they will receive the pin

for the appropriate age level.

In addition, two platinum letters will be awarded each year in the form of a plaque. The platinum letters are based on overall achievement and may be received at any age level. Platinum awards are selected from all applications submitted in that 4-H program year.
