Poultry Show Rules

- Entries must be postmarked by May 5th or hand delivered to the Extension office by that date.
- Entry fee's \$10 per exhibitor, \$5 for showmanship and \$5 per chicken or waterfowl exhibited. No turkeys or pigeons will be shown at this show.
- Any bird showing signs of illness or contagious diseases/parasites will be removed from the show and isolated, entry fees will not be reimbursed.
- Any birds signed up for the show but not able to make it to the show will not be reimbursed entry fee.
- Please know what breed, variety(color), age and sex of your bird, this will make it easier for you to enter it in the correct class. Your birds will be judged by which class you put them in. If they are in the wrong class the judge may disqualify an entry.
- Judging for the show will be based on the latest edition APA and ABA Standards of Perfection book.
- Pullets-female under one (1) year of age. Cockerel-male bird under one (1) year of age. Cockmale bird over one (1) year and a Hen-female over one (1) year old.
- A numbered leg band is recommended for each bird to help identify it if were to get out of its pen. A colored zip tie can also be used.
- Un-sportsman like conduct will not be tolerated, anyone, kids or adults will be asked to leave.
- All entered birds need to be cooped in by 8:30 am Saturday May 13th at McGee Park.
- The Poultry Show will start Saturday may 13th at 9:00 am, Showmanship will follow the breed classes, Senior, Junior, Novice, and Pre-Novice Showmanship classes.
- For exact species information, color varieties and breed characteristics refer to an ABA or APA Standard of Perfection Books.
