

All 4-H indoor entries MUST BE PRE-REGISTERED by July 24, 2025 to be exhibited at the fair.

CHECK-IN: Saturday, August 9th from 10am to 2pm at the San Juan

County Fairgrounds, McGee Park Multi-Purpose Building.

CHECK-OUT: McGee Park Multi-Purpose Building, Sunday, August 17th, 10:00 am-2:00 pm

Family members or club leaders may check-in/ check-out exhibits for members.

Special Rules:

For complete rules, project descriptions and guidelines see Exhibitor Handbook.

- 1. All 4-H project exhibits will be entered free of charge. All pre-registered exhibits will be accepted for judging at the above check-in time and date. Only 4-H entry staff will be allowed to place exhibits in position for judging.
- 2. Exhibitors in this section must be enrolled in the appropriate 4-H project to compete in a given class. EACH EXHIBIT MUST BE COMPLETE AS LISTED UNDER PROJECT GUIDELINES. Exhibits must be the work of the 4-H exhibitor, meet project requirements and have been completed within the current 4-H year.
- 3. No interference with the judges will be allowed. Only the 4-H Department Head and entry staff will be allowed in the exhibit hall while judging is in progress. DISPLAY AREA WILL NOT BE OPEN UNTIL JUDGING IS COMPLETE AND EXHIBITS ARE IN PLACE. Judges are instructed to award premiums only if articles are deemed worthy of merit and meet 4-H project guidelines. The judge's decisions are final.
- 4. Only items placing first WITH proper paperwork THAT MEET SIZE REQUIRMENTS will be eligible to continue to the NM State Fair. State Fair Legos must be glued!
- 5. According to NM 4-H Policy, Cloverbud members are not eligible for competition however we encourage them to enter Cloverbud project work to be displayed. Cloverbud projects do not have to be pre-registered. Cloverbud entries are not eligible to be entered at the NM State Fair.
- 6. NO LIVE ANIMALS are to be exhibited, this includes fish and insects.
- 7. All baked good must be brought on disposable plates or in a disposable container.

Best of Show Cake: 4-H Member does NOT need to be in the cake project. Cakes must be entered with an information binder. All ages compete for one prize. Prize: Buckle and Cash Payout.

Map of Check-In for 2025 SJCF






