No more than two (2) officers shall be elected from the same club in a given year.

- * Assist with **County 4-H Officer Trainings** (Fall / Winter)
- * Participate in **4-H Day at the Roundhouse** (January/February)
- * Participate in planning and conducting **4-H Day Camp** (March)
- * Assist with **County 4-H Carnival & Concession** (March)
- * Attend **San Juan Basin 4-H Leadership Camp, Hesperus** (Spring)
- * Assist with **County 4-H Contests and Awards Programs** (June)
- * Participate in at least one **County Contest** (June)
- * **Complete a 4-H record book** in at least one project area (October)
- * Assist with **Annual 4-H Year-End Awards Banquet** (December)
