- \* Assist with County 4-H Carnival & Concession (March)
- \* Attend San Juan Basin 4-H Leadership Camp, Hesperus (Spring)
- \* Assist with County 4-H Contests and Awards Programs (June)
- \* Participate in at least one County Contest (June)
- \* Complete a 4-H record book in at least one project area (October)
- \* Assist with Annual 4-H Year-End Awards Banquet (December)
